### RE: STRONG OPPOSITION TO Item 20-0147-S39, 20-0147-S15, 20-0147-S42

Dear Councilmembers,

My name is Hunter G. Hall and I am a hospitality professional in Los Angeles. **I have several clients in each of your districts.** I also work with, and on behalf of, many other restaurants in LA County, and in LA City.

**We urge you to consider the needs of restaurants and the hospitality industry, which is one of the largest sources of sales tax in the city and state.** You must **also take into account the tangentially related businesses** (*small manufacturing businesses, suppliers, farmers, butchers, etc.*) who rely on the hospitality industry. Many of them are small businesses who will be irrevocably harmed during this unstable time.

**You must STRONGLY OPPOSE Item 20-0147-S39 the way it's currently written. This will bankrupt every restaurant, bar and retail store in Los Angeles and the related businesses that depend on them. They will never be able to reopen if they are forced to pay what is effectively a 2-week severance to every single employee because they were forced to shut down. This is one of the most destructive pieces of legislation I have ever seen.**

**We 100% agree that employees need immediate financial support, but The City of Los Angeles and The State of CA should pick up the tab, not small employers.**

I suspect you're trying to mirror what San Francisco did, but **they only asked for 5 days, and THE CITY OF S.F. PAID FOR IT**. *They did not put it on the backs of small businesses, which was far wiser and more well informed.*

Please note that if passed, **these requirements would be ON TOP of the FFCRA**, a federal piece of legislation that goes into effect April 1<sup>st</sup> that requires up to 80hrs of leave for similar reasons for businesses with fewer than 500 employees. You read that right... *FEWER than 500 employees*. There is **NO NEED to add additional burdens to small businesses as many will simply close permanently to avoid this insanity**. Don't be the reason that happens...

**We also ask that you please oppose Motions 20-0147-S15 and 20-0147-S42. Both motions will make it harder to bring our employees back as soon as possible. Although these rules may be applicable to other businesses, independent restaurants would struggle and be unable to reopen quickly if this ordinance took effect.**

In the past few days, every restaurant and bar in the City has been forced to close or pivot to accommodate delivery-only and takeout. This is a band-aid, not a permanent solution. **They are hanging on for a lifeline from you, so don't throw them an anchor.**

Our employees are family to us. Since the mandated shut-down, we have done everything possible to take care of them for as long as this may last and work to **make sure they have a job to come back to when we are able to reopen**. However, these **proposed ordinances will end up hurting our employees more than they would help them**.

Please understand how your vote will affect both the restaurant employees and small business owners. Our number one priority is to support and provide for every one of these employees but **I also want to ensure that they will have a job to come back to once the COVID-19 crisis passes**.

**If these three motions pass, there won't be any jobs for anyone.**

Dear Councilmember Blumenfield,

My name is Hunter G. Hall and I am a hospitality professional in Los Angeles. **I have several clients in your District.** I also work with, and on behalf of, many other restaurants in LA County, and in LA City.

**We urge you to consider the needs of restaurants and the hospitality industry, which is one of the largest sources of sales tax in the city and state.** You must also take into account the tangentially related businesses (*small manufacturing businesses, suppliers, farmers, butchers, etc.*) who rely on the hospitality industry. Many of them are small businesses that will be irrevocably harmed during this unstable time.

**You must STRONGLY OPPOSE Item 20-0147-S39 the way it's currently written. This will bankrupt every restaurant, bar and retail store in Los Angeles and the related businesses that depend on them.** They will never be able to reopen if they are forced to pay what is effectively a 2-week severance to every single employee because they were forced to shut down. **This is one of the most destructive pieces of legislation I have ever seen.**

**We 100% agree that employees need immediate financial support, but The City of Los Angeles and The State of CA should pick up the tab, not small employers.**

I suspect you're trying to mirror what San Francisco did, but **they only asked for 5 days, and THE CITY OF S.F. PAID FOR IT.** *They did not put it on the backs of small businesses, which was far wiser and more well informed.*

Please note that if passed, **these requirements would be ON TOP of the FFCRA,** a federal piece of legislation that goes into effect April 1<sup>st</sup> that requires up to 80hrs of leave for similar reasons for businesses with fewer than 500 employees.
