

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the non-monetary donation of dispute resolution training valued at \$60,000 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the non-monetary donation of \$60,000 for dispute resolution course for the benefit of the Risk Management and Policies Division of the LAPD.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 26, 2020, your Committee considered a November 12, 2019 Board report relative to the non-monetary donation of dispute resolution training valued at \$60,000 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). According to the Board, the LAPD-Pepperdine University Workplace Conflict Resolution course was developed by the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution, Pepperdine University's School of Law, and the LAPD. The course contains a curriculum that is mindful of the law enforcement workplace, and focuses on tactical and interpersonal skills which are necessary for supervisors to handle the needs of LAPD personnel and fluid and dynamic workplace conflicts. If approved, the donation will benefit Risk Management and Policies Division by providing funding for two conflict resolution courses for a minimum of 80 sworn and civilian LAPD supervisors. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
