A freeze or suspension that expects Angelenos to cover an average of 4x that, per month of disrupted wages, is cruel and tone deaf in the face of the largest threat to our way of life in nearly a century. Defend your constituents. Defend Los Angeles. Pass a rent and mortgage moratorium and show us that you care about this city and the people who live here.
