Comments for Public Posting: Hi there, Please help us, many of us live paycheck to paycheck. We NEED a rent FREEZE NOW. not a payback program. I work as an independent contractor and am self employed in events and music entertainment at events. In a matter of a few days I have lost ALL my clients and events for the foreseeable future. The amount of money I have lost is critical, i'm not even sure I can recover from this in the long term and your citizens need help and relief NOW. Although unemployment insurance may help once the federal government passes the stimulus bill for now I am left with absolutely no way to pay bills or rent for April which is only one week away. I am not alone, thousands and thousands of us are here in the city that have LOST OUR LIVELIHOOD and jobs and are freaking out about paying rent next week. We NEED A freeze on BOTH rent and Mortgages, how can landlords be aloud to have a forbearance for 90 days but renters still must pay? We cannot even work to pay it! Many other countries are adopting this "Freeze" as an emergency measure to help there citizens. I would also like to point out the unemployment that we will eventually receive and the stimulus will still NOT cover my rent, food and bills in Los Angeles not even close- the only fair thing is to put it all in freeze till things are open again. The stimulus money is NOT coming by april 1st and it will not be enough. Your no eviction policy also doesn't help for individuals who live paycheck to paycheck owing back rent and paying it back over six months is not only stressful it's IMPOSSIBLE. The notion that this is going to last till may most likely and we will then owe months of back rent is absolutly Crippling and although you have put a hold on evictions for 6 months - after that six month period you will see a wave of people loosing there homes.
