Motion

As of the 2019 Point in Time Homeless Count, there were over 27,000 unsheltered Angelenos living on the streets of the City. As permanent supportive housing comes on line, it is important to implement quick, cost effective, temporary housing solutions in the interim.

There are various community based organizations, service providers, faith based organizations and public offices located in Council District 7 with physical footprints that can potentially accommodate more resources on their campuses.

In light of the State providing municipalities with emergency trailers from past emergency events for interim housing, we should explore opportunities to receive and operate those trailers, or invest in new ones to provide those same shelter services.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council Instruct the City Administrative Officer and the Chief Legislative Analyst to submit to the Homeless Strategy Committee for review a funding request totaling \$300,000 for the acquisition and siting of five trailers to be used for temporary shelter in Council District 7.
