Comments for Public Posting: Hello, As a small restaurant owner, we're very passionate about the fees that delivery apps charge and feel it should be regulated by the gov't, but have been informed that there's currently no meeting date set for the committee it has been assigned to. We're obviously extremely concerned about this motion getting voted on promptly, as it's a hugely relevant and pressing issue for all restaurant businesses in the city...and LA is behind the curve in enforcing this protective and supportive measure. As I'm sure you've heard from other constituents, some of the delivery apps have offered a discounted rate, but many only go through the end of this month. (Such is the case with Caviar -- they've reduced their take to 10%, but that expires May 31.) We feel adamant that a fee cap (at 10%) that remains in place until all restrictions on restaurant operations are lifted is an essential element to the survival of our industry.
