
MOTION

Council District Seven would like to repurpose funding currently earmarked in the Department of Cultural Affairs budget for the Hansen Dam July 4th Fireworks Event to fund multi-layered art and cultural programming efforts in response to the COVID-19 crisis to serve residents in the district.

The programming would include, but not be limited to, providing art supplies and art kits to hundreds of low income families living in motels, hiring local musicians, including mariachis, traditional bandas and folklórico groups, for virtual free performances, and hiring local artists and businesses in the district to design and create fashionable face masks.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$75,000 be transferred / appropriated within the Cultural Affairs Fund No.100-30 from Account No. 009857 (Hansen Dam Fireworks) to a new Account entitled "CD-7 COVID-19 Programming" to serve residents of the Seventh District with Arts and Cultural Programming in Response to COVID-19, as further detailed in the text of this Motion.
