For your future use, I have attached a copy of the 2024 Quick Reference and Ballot Measures Calendars for the 2024 Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections. These Calendars list legal and practical deadlines for activities related to placing measures onto the next Election's ballot.

As a reminder, these dates are intended for reference purposes only. Some of the future Council Recess dates are tentative.

Also, please be aware that, with few noted exceptions, we have listed the *legal* (absolute) deadlines. Thus, it is advisable to schedule activities well in advance of these dates so that deadlines are not missed due to Council Recess, emergencies, or other unscheduled events.

These are key election calendar events and their corresponding dates. Some events reflect the practical deadlines, which may differ from the statutory deadlines, as explained in the footnotes. It is advisable to schedule activities well in advance of the dates listed to avoid the possibility of missing the deadline.

¹ Recommended (not legal) filing date to ensure compliance with deadlines that follow.

² The legal deadline of E-125 falls on 7/3/24 but must precede the E-110 deadline for adopting all resolutions. Since the E-110 deadline falls during Council Recess, the E-125 deadline is moved another 15 days ahead.

³ The legal deadline of E-110 falls on an anticipated Council Recess day (11/16/23); therefore, the deadline is moved up to the preceding Tuesday. Resolutions of Necessity for bond measures must be adopted at the meeting before the final election resolutions are adopted.

⁴ The legal deadline of E-110 falls on an anticipated Council Recess day (7/18/24); therefore, the deadline is moved up to the Wednesday preceding a holiday and anticipated Council Recess. Resolutions of Necessity for bond measures must be adopted at the meeting before the final election resolutions are adopted.

⁵ The legal deadlines of E-64 and E-60 fall on a Holiday (1/1/2024) and during Council Recess, respectively; therefore, the deadlines are moved up to the preceding Monday and Friday ahead Council Recess days.

⁶ The legal deadline of E-64 falls on a holiday (9/2/2024); therefore, the deadline is moved up to the preceding Friday.

⁷ Last day for Council action to approve or disapprove Ballot Simplification Committee Summaries (if no action by this date, summaries are automatically approved) [Election Code Section 405].
