ORDINANCE NO. 159100

3 An ordinance calling a Special Recall Election to be
4 held on Tuesday, the 21st day of August, 1984 for the
5 purpose of submitting to a vote of the electors of the
6 Fourteenth Council District of The City of Los Angeles the
7 question whether Arthur K. Snyder, Councilman of the
8 Fourteenth District, shall be recalled, and if recalled, for
9 the election of his successor for the remainder of the term.

11 Whereas, on the 21st day of February, 1984, a petition
12 was filed with the City Clerk of The City of Los Angeles
13 demanding the submission to the electors of the Fourteenth
14 Council District the question whether Arthur K. Snyder,
15 Councilman of the Fourteenth District, shall be removed by
16 vote of such electors, and, if so removed, the election of
17 his successor for the remainder of the term; and

19 Whereas, on the 7th day of June, 1984, the City Clerk
20 attached a certificate showing that said petition contains
21 signatures equal in number to at least 15% of the qualified
22 registered electors of said 14th Council District; and

24 Whereas, on the 8th day of June, 1984, the City Clerk
25 presented said petition with said certificate thereto
26 attached to the City Council, and said City Council did on
27 the 8th day of June, 1984, determine that Tuesday, August
28 21st, 1984, would be an appropriate date for holding a
29 Special Recall Election for the purpose of submitting to the
30 electors of the Fourteenth Council District the question
31 whether said Arthur K. Snyder, a member of the Council from
32 the Fourteenth Council District of The City of Los Angeles,
33 shall be recalled, and, if recalled, for the election of his
34 successor for the remainder of the term;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO
37 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
38

39 Section 1. That a Special Recall Election be, and the
40 same is hereby, called and shall be held in the Fourteenth
41 Council District of The City of Los Angeles, on Tuesday, the
42 21st day of August, 1984, for the purpose of submitting to
43 the qualified electors of said Fourteenth Council District
44 the question whether Arthur K. Snyder, a member of the
45 Council from the Fourteenth Council District of The City of
46 Los Angeles, shall be recalled, and, if recalled, for the
47 election of his successor for the remainder of the term.

49 Sec. 2. That for the purpose of holding and conducting
50 said Special Recall Election in the Fourteenth Council
51 District hereby called, the said Fourteenth Council District
52 is hereby divided into 101 election precincts, with numbers
53 and boundaries of Election Precincts heretofore established
54 and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles
55 County for the holding of State and County elections in
56 territory embraced within said Fourteenth Council District
57 of The City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of
58 California. The election precincts, polling places, and

1 officers of election set forth in the list heretofore
2 prepared and approved by the City Clerk and to be filed in
3 his office on June 20, 1984, are hereby approved and
4 established as the precincts and the polling places for said
5 election precincts, and the persons whose names and
6 addresses are set forth in such list are hereby named as
7 members of the precinct boards for said election precincts;
8 and such list is, by reference, hereby approved and
9 incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as if
10 herein fully set forth, and the City Clerk is hereby
11 instructed to post one copy of such list on the bulletin
12 board of the Council, one in the City Clerk's main office,
13 and one in the Election Division thereof, and such list
14 shall remain posted until the day after election.
15

16 Sec. 3. That the polls of said election shall be open
17 at seven o'clock in the morning of the day of election, to
18 wit: the 21st day of August, 1984, and shall be kept open
19 until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day, when the polls
20 shall be closed, except as provided in Section 180 of the
21 Los Angeles City Election Code.
22

23 Sec. 4. It is hereby ordered that the election boards
24 in those precincts designated in Section 2 hereof shall
25 consist of one Inspector, one Judge, and two Clerks.
26

27 Sec. 5. That in all particulars not recited in this
28 ordinance said election be held as provided by the Charter
29 of The City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles City Election
30 Code and other applicable law.
