

TRADE, COMMERCE, AND TECHNOLOGY and PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEES REPORT relative to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) and the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) for aerial patrols and specialized missions services.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE the MOA, attested by the City Attorney on June 17, 2015, attached to the Council file.
2. AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAPD, to execute the attached MOA, on behalf of the City, with the Harbor Department.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on August 4, 2015, your Trade, Commerce and Technology Committee considered a Board of Police Commissioners (Board) report relative to the Memorandum of Agreement between the Harbor Department and the Police Department for aerial patrols and specialized missions services. The Board reports that the Harbor Department requests LAPD to provide police and aerial support on a cash overtime basis as directed in the MOA and will reimburse the LAPD for services provided throughout Fiscal Year 2015-2016. The reimbursement funding for this MOA has been increased from \$100,000 to \$135,000. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the transmittal.

Subsequently, on August 18, 2015 the Public Safety Committee also considered this matter and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Public Safety Committee concurred with the recommendations of the Trade, Commerce and Technology Committee. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
