

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed contract with MV Transportation, Inc. (MV Transportation) for the continued operation of the Cityride Dial-a-Ride Program from February 1, 2016 to January 31, 2021.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), to execute a contract with MV Transportation for the operation of the Cityride Dial-a-Ride Program for a term of three years, plus two one-year renewal options, for a total of five years from February 1, 2016 to January 31, 2021, subject to the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no General Fund impact. Funding is available for the proposed contract for operation of the Cityride Program within the Proposition A Local Transit Assistance Fund. Funding for subsequent years of the contract will be provided in those fiscal year budgets. The above recommendation complies with City Financial Policies in that sufficient special fund revenues are available and eligible for this purpose.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 9, 2015, your Committee considered a December 3, 2015 CAO report relative to a proposed contract with MV Transportation for the continued operation of the Cityride Dial-a-Ride Program from February 1, 2016 to January 31, 2021. According to the CAO, the LADOT is requesting authority to execute a three year contract with two one-year options for a total of five years with MV Transportation for the continued operation of the Cityride Dial-A-Ride Program from February 1, 2016 to January 31, 2021. The total cost of the contract will not exceed \$26.5 million and includes technology enhancements, expanded marketing support to increase ridership and reduced hourly rates.

The City's Dial-A-Ride Program covers three areas of the City:

- a. North (Area 1) - San Fernando Valley
- b. Central (Area 2) - Central Los Angeles
- c. (Area 3) - South Los Angeles

The Program provides transit service for eligible seniors and individuals with disabilities who live in the City of Los Angeles. The Proposition A Local Transit Assistance Fund will support the cost of this contract over the three years, including the potential time extensions and will be provided through the annual budget process.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to

recommend approval of the contract as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its approval.
