## RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners REVIEW and APPROVE the attached Application for Special Reward Payment.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council the Application for Special Reward Payment for review and approval.

## DISCUSSION

On May 5, 2007, Mario Jackson and Tierney Yates were murdered inside the "Magic Wheels Private Club" located at 10974 South Broadway. Detectives John Zambos, Serial No. 23110, and Leo Kerchenske, Serial No. 24341, were the lead investigators. Detective Michael Owens, Serial No. 32795, was later assigned to the investigation. Initially, none of the witnesses were willing to cooperate. Although there were leads for the investigators to pursue, no one was willing to identify the perpetrator.

On September 18, 2007, a \$50,000 reward was introduced by the Los Angeles City Council for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of the person responsible for this double murder.

Subsequently, a witness provided information to the detectives indicating that he knew the identity of the killer. Charon McMichael, a "Raymond Avenue Crip" street gang member, admitted to the witness that he had shot and killed the victims. Although the witness initially came forward with this information on July 11, 2007, his on-going assistance was required in order to file murder charges on the defendant.

On October 20, 2008, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office filed two counts of murder on McMichael because of the information provided by said witness. An arrest warrant was obtained, and McMichael was later arrested in Las Vegas, Nevada, with the assistance of the witness. On November 6, 2008, McMichael was extradited to Los Angeles to face murder charges. The murder trial resulted in a hung jury. McMichael eventually pled guilty to two counts of 192(a) PC Voluntary Manslaughter, and was sentenced to 30 years in prison. The Witness testified at both the preliminary hearing and the jury trial.

It is the opinion of Detective III Richard Gordon that the witness is eligible for the reward offer. The information he provided enabled murder charges to be filed on the defendant. The witness was directly responsible for the identification, apprehension, and conviction of Charon McMichael. Based on these facts, it is requested that the reward funds be paid to the witness listed on the attached Applications for Special Reward Payment.

The witness name was not included in this document to protect the identify and safety of the witness.

The witness contacted detectives and provided information regarding the suspect making admissions to killing the victims. The information provided by the witness enabled murder charges to be filed against the suspect, Charon McMichael. Witness-1 also assisted the detectives by providing information regarding the whereabouts of the suspect. Witness-1's actions were instrumental in the arrest of the suspect. Witness-1 testified in the preliminary hearing and trial of People V. Charon McMichael, Case TA111066. The trial resulted in a hung jury. Prior to the retrial, McMichael pled guilty to two counts of 192(a) PC. He was sentenced to (30) years in prison. The case against McMichael would not have prosecuted without the information provided by witness-1.
