An application package to name Sherman Oaks was filed on 9/23/08 and approved on 10/8/08.

The application package was referred to Education and Neighborhoods Committee on 10/14/08.

The Sherman Oaks and Van Nuys Neighborhood Councils conducted a Public Hearing on January 12 and 14, 2009. The Lake Balboa and Greater Valley Glen Neighborhood Councils did not hold hearings.

Additionally, on 6/18/09, the City Clerk distributed approximately 1,800 public hearing notices to residents within the affected boundaries of the public hearing scheduled for 6/23/09.
