

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the inclusion of Fair Trade requirements in the current review of the City's Environmentally Preferable Products Purchasing Program (EPPP) Ordinance.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Koretz - Buscaino - Bonin - Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), with assistance from the Department of General Services (GSD), the Chief Procurement Officer, City Attorney's Office, and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to include Fair Trade requirements in the current review of the EPPP Ordinance; and, report back to the Council within 60 days with recommendations on how to best include it in the EPPP.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has submitted a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting of August 18, 2020, the Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee considered Motion (Koretz - Buscaino - Bonin - Blumenfield) relative to the inclusion of Fair Trade requirements in the current review of the EPPP Ordinance. The Motion instructs the BOS, with assistance from the GSD, Procurement Officer, City Attorney's Office, and the CLA to report back with recommendations on how to best include it in the City's EPPP. Fair Trade is an innovative, market-based system that ensures fair labor practice, healthy and safe work environments, fair prices, worker empowerment, community investment, and environmentally sustainable practices and products.

After providing the opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
