

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to initiating street vacation proceedings for Vantage Avenue between Archwood Street and the alley south of Vanowen Street.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino – Krekorian):

DIRECT the Bureau of Engineering to:

- a. Initiate street vacation proceedings for Vantage Avenue between Archwood Street and the alley south of Vanowen Street, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.
- b. Process this vacation request under Council File No. 09-0856, Engineering work order No. E1401145, and apply the conditions established under the Council action of November 3, 2010.
- c. Report to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee relative to the feasibility of vacating the requested area.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On February 17, 2016, Council considered Motion (Buscaino – Krekorian) relative to initiating street vacation proceedings for Vantage Avenue between Archwood Street and the alley south of Vanowen Street. Motion states that on November 3, 2010, Council conditionally approved the vacation. Vacation conditions, however, were not complied with prior to the expiration of the approval. The Los Angeles Unified School District, owner of the properties, has submitted a new application requesting to vacate the same streets and alleys. Motion movers recommend that Council direct the Bureau of Engineering to take the steps necessary to proceed with the requested vacation. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its special meeting held April 11, 2016, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendations.
