RECOMMENDATIONS:

- E. That following Council adoption, Resolution to Vacate No. 19-1401147, be transmitted to the Land Development and GIS Division of the Bureau of Engineering for recordation of the Resolution with the County Recorder.

DISCUSSION:

Resolution to Vacate: At the meeting of the City Council on June 25, 2013, no protests were filed against this vacation. All conditions of the Council's action of May 22, 2013, under Council File No. 09-1381 have been fulfilled. The Resolution to Vacate is being presented pursuant to Council instructions of May 22, 2013.

Resolution to Vacate No. 19-1401147 has been approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney. This Resolution to Vacate includes the reservation of easement to the City of Los Angeles in conjunction with the existing Santa Fe Viaduct.
