### **When Things Don't Go As Planned**

Despite the forethought and concern we put into every permit we coordinate, and despite our ongoing commitment to protect area neighborhoods from needless inconvenience, sometimes things do not go quite as planned. Admittedly, there have been times when we have failed to uncover and address all of the concerns of area residents. We have also seen filmmakers willfully violate our carefully-crafted permit terms -- to your frustration and ours alike.

If you have concerns about filming in progress, we recommend you first contact the production company and see if they are able to assist you. If you cannot obtain an on-site resolution from the production company, we ask that you call us at FilmL.A.

Under no circumstances should you attempt to interrupt, delay or interfere with duly-permitted filming activities. In the City of Los Angeles, willful interference with duly-permitted on-location filming is a violation of Section 41.20 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, punishable by arrest and fines. The same policy bars production companies from filming without a permit.

### **Filming On-Location: Part 9**

While filming is ongoing, you are also expected to be available to assist us in responding to any community concerns that arise. Our employees are available 24/7 to assist you and the community with unexpected challenges.

Under no circumstances should your duly-permitted filming activities be intentionally impeded by any party. In the City of Los Angeles, willful interference with duly-permitted on-location filming is a violation of Section 41.20 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code. Violators who attempt to disrupt permitted productions are subject to arrest and civil penalties.
