TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) regarding oversized vehicle parking.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rosendahl - LaBonge for Hahn):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance and cooperation of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), to prepare and present an ordinance amending LAMC Chapter VIII, Sections 80.69.4, 80.76.2, and 89.60 that prohibits or limits parking of oversized vehicles on certain streets between 2 AM and 6 AM as follows:

1. Revise the definition of oversized vehicles.
2. Provide a process for a Councilmember to establish oversized vehicle restrictions if no permits are involved.
3. Allow the LADOT to install oversized vehicle parking restriction signs at the request of a Councilmember.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis on this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a meeting held on January 13, 2010, the Transportation Committee considered Motion (Rosendahl - LaBonge for Hahn) relative to amending the LAMC regarding oversized vehicle parking. An opportunity for public comment was held. Afterwards, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
