The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit related projects, curb and sidewalk improvements and all expenses relating or incidental to each Council District.

The Topanga Police Station will be installing a 2x2 ft brass plaque stating the origins of the name "Topanga". Named by the indigenous Tongva tribe, Topanga means "a place above." The designation of this land is pertinent to the cultural identity of the community that took root in the Topanga canyon region. Topanga has a rich and fascinating history for which this plaque will commemorate. Recognizing the origins of the name as well as other important historical facts, the plaque will be sure to inspire a sense of community and pride for those who see it. It is an important asset in our ongoing attempt to beautify our city and inspire a sense of belonging and community in our district's residents.

The Topanga Police Station will be installing this plaque on a 3 foot high cement mount by the station's entrance way. The mount will provide the plaque with a visible, aesthetically pleasing and prominent location while also doubling as a protective bollard from vehicular threats to the safety of the station. A request has been made to Council District 12 to cover the costs of the Installation Work Order. The cost to the City would be \$7,352 - (Contact person is Officer Grace Hsieh N1749@lapd.lacity.org)

There are sufficient funds in the Council District Twelve Street Furniture Revenue Fund which can be transferred to the Topanga Police Department to cover the costs of the Installation Work Order.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council:

1. Transfer \$7,352 from the Council District 12 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 to the Public Works Trust Fund No. 100/40, Account 1014 (Construction Salaries) to cover the costs of the plaque's installation in the 3-foot high concrete mount.
2. Authorize the Chief Legislative Analyst, or his designee, to make technical corrections or revisions as may be necessary to implement the intent of this motion.
