TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE relative to prohibiting any person from offering to pay or paying an owner or employee of a hotel or other business establishment for directing any passenger to ride in a specific automobile-for-hire or taxicab.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT accompanying ORDINANCE amending Chapter VII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to add Section 71.28 to prohibit any person from offering to pay or paying an owner of a hotel or other business establishment, or the owner's employees or agents, or for the owner of a hotel or other business establishment, or the owner's employees or agents, to accept payment, for directing any passenger without a reservation made on a pre-arranged basis to ride in a specific Automobile-For-Hire or Taxicab in the city of Los Angeles.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

Accompanying a report to Council dated December 7, 2012 (attached to the Council file), the City Attorney presents Ordinance amending the LAMC to prohibit any person from offering to pay or paying an owner or employee of a hotel or other business establishment for directing any passenger to ride in a specific automobile-for-hire or taxicab.
