

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) agreement with the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) for environmental services provided by the HCIDLA's Environmental and Land Use Services Unit.

Recommendations for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, HCIDLA, or designee to negotiate and execute an amended inter-agency agreement with HACLA for provision of professional environmental services for HACLA by the HCIDLA's Environmental and Land Use Services Unit, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality and the National Environmental Policy Acts, and other relevant federal, state, and local land use and environmental laws and regulations, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The HCIDLA reports that this action will not impact the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor dated April 26, 2016, HCIDLA requests authority to amend the agreement with HACLA for environmental services by HCIDLA's Environmental and Land Use Services. HCIDLA reports that the proposed amendment will extend the term of the contract for one year through June 30, 2016, and also expand the scope of services to address environmental clearance issues for complex projects such as Jordan Downs Redevelopment Project, Dana Strand Housing Project, and for other services previously unanticipated.

At its meeting held June 15, 2015, the Housing Committee discussed this matter with a representative of HCIDLA. Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed contract amendment requested by HCIDLA.
