Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer or the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.



SUMMARY

On April 21, 2010, the Chair of the Public Works Committee considered a Motion (LaBonge - Krekorian) relative to necessary actions to effectuate the paving of Clybourn Avenue between Riverside Drive and Toluca Lake Avenue prior to the close of the current fiscal year. According to the Motion, Clybourn Avenue in between Riverside Drive and Toluca Lake Avenue has numerous potholes and has not been resurfaced in over 20 years. Funds have been included in the BOSS Street Resurfacing Program but the work has not been completed due to complications arising from Clybourn Avenue being located in both the City of Burbank and the City of Los Angeles and the street has not been resurfaced in over 20 years.

After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair moved to recommend approval of the Motion as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
