

Clybourn Avenue in between Riverside Drive and Toluca Lake Avenue in Council District 4 has numerous potholes and has been in an overall state of disrepair for years. The public routinely voices its concern relative to the street's resurfacing needs and funds have been included in the Bureau of Street Services' (BOSS) street resurfacing program. However, the work has not been completed due to complications arising from Clybourn Avenue being located in both the City of Burbank and the City of Los Angeles. BOSS states that the street has not been resurfaced in over 20 years.

Council District 4 and City staff have been in contact with the City of Burbank to coordinate the expeditious resurfacing of Clybourn Avenue to the benefit of both cities. BOSS advises that the City of Burbank is willing to participate in the process and the City Attorney has begun the preparation of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The MOU has not been finalized, but would provide that the City of Los Angeles be responsible for resurfacing Clybourn Avenue this year with the City of Burbank being responsible the next time resurfacing is required. BOSS states that funds are available to resurface the street and estimates the costs to be approximately \$110,000.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Attorney be requested and the Bureau of Street Services be instructed to report relative to the necessary actions to effectuate the paving of Clybourn Avenue between Riverside Drive and Toluca Lake Avenue in Council District 4 prior to the close of the current fiscal year.
