Subject: Naming of Community of Harbor Pines – CF 10-1513

The Bureau of Engineering has reviewed the application submitted to change the community name of a neighborhood in the Wilmington-Harbor City community plan area. The application proposes renaming the neighborhood as Harbor Pines.

Some of the properties shown on the map accompanying the application are in the City of Lomita, not inside the City of Los Angeles.

Our record of community names as used on our city maps and tract maps show no reference to the name Harbor Pines. This area is in the Wilmington-Harbor City Community Plan area and the Harbor City Neighborhood Council District. The properties are in Council District 15 except for those parcels west of Alta Vista which are outside the City of Los Angeles.

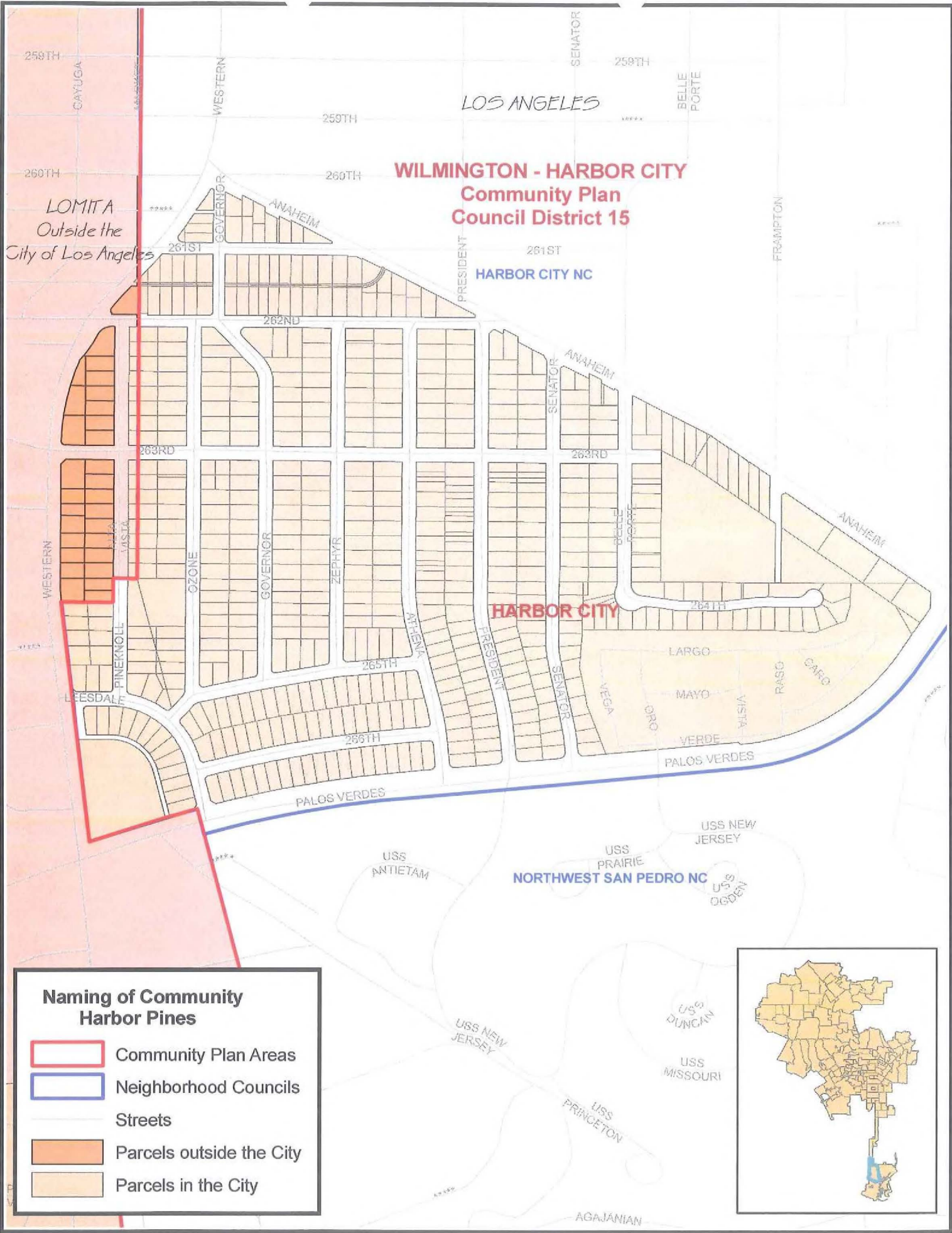
Based upon our community name maps, the properties, within the City, currently are considered to be within zip code 90710 and the community of Harbor City.

The attached map shows the parcels in the area that are proposed to be included in the new community as shown on the application and those properties that are outside the City's boundary.

The Bureau of Engineering has no additional pertinent information concerning the historical use of this name for this neighborhood in the community.

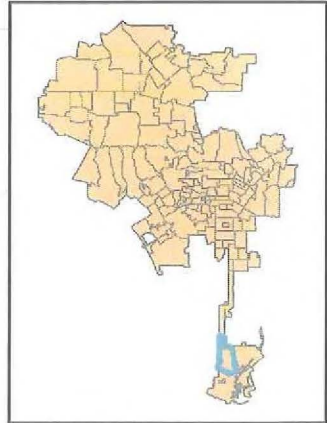

The Los Angeles City Council, at its meeting on January 31, 2006 (Council File 02-0196), adopted a policy for the naming and renaming of a community.
