On January 22, 2020, the Public Safety Committee considered a Motion (Koretz - Harris-Dawson - Krekorian) relative to the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) progress in hiring civilian employees. . After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to make the following recommendations:

Instruct the LAPD, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Personnel Department to report in 30 days in regard to progress made in hiring civilian employees with said report to include:

- a. The number of current civilian vacancies in LAPD.
- b. How long it is currently taking to recruit, hire and train a civilian employee.
- c. The number of civilians hired into the LAPD over the previous two years.
- d. How many officers have been reassigned from civilian duties to patrol; and, any recommended policy changes to expedite the civilian hiring process.
- e. The status of civilian vacancies in the LAPD that support analysis of rape kits, DNA, Latent Prints and Firearms.
