PERSONNEL COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a fourth year extension of a contract with GovernmentJobs.Com, Inc. (doing business as NeoGov) to provide automation of the Civil Service Selection Process.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager or designee, Personnel Department, to negotiate and execute a fourth year extension of Contract C-113556 with NeoGov to provide automation of the Civil Service Selection Process from June 5, 2011 through June 5, 2012, with an option to extend the contract for a fifth year.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Personnel Department reports that there is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its April 20, 2011 meeting, your Committee considered a Personnel Department report relative to a fourth year extension of a contract with NeoGov to provide automation of the Civil Service Selection Process. In its March 22, 2011 report, attached to the Council file, the Department provides background information on this issue. During the discussion of this item, the Department's representative provided an overview of the report and responded to related questions from the Committee members. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council concur with the Department's recommendation, as reflected above.
