Subject: **AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT \$400,000 OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE MOBILE SOURCE AIR POLLUTION REDUCTION REVIEW COMMITTEE'S 2013-2014 EDITION LOCAL GOVERNMENT MATCH PROGRAM IN SUPPORT OF THE BUREAU OF SANITATION CLEAN FUEL PROGRAM FOR SOLID RESOURCES COLLECTION VEHICLES**

As recommended in the accompanying report of the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, which this Board has adopted, the Board of Public Works requests that the City Council, subject to concurrence by the Mayor, authorize the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to accept \$400,000 in grant funds from the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC), to conduct all negotiations, to provide additional information, and to execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, agreements and amendments, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, which may be necessary to secure funding with respect to the purchase of 14 new natural gas heavy-duty Solid Resources Collection Vehicles (SRCV). (Execute and submit MSRC Contract No. ML14013).


It is also requested, that City Council adopt the Resolution (Transmittal No. 2) approving the acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$400,000 and appointing the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents necessary to accept and expend grant funding for the purchase of 14 new heavy-duty natural gas powered SRCV.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the General Fund. The total funding for this project is not to exceed \$4.9 million for the purchase of 14 new natural gas heavy-duty SRCV. The amount is available in the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Bond, Series 2013-A (Fund 55L, Dept. 50, Appropriation Unit 50J303).

The MSRC will reimburse the Bureau of Sanitation up to \$400,000, once contract conditions have been met. The monies will be deposited in Alternative Fuel Program Fund 45T, Dept. 50, Dept. Revenue Source Code 336100.
