MOTION

On December 26, 2008, Ordinance No 180,446 created the Off-Site Sign Periodic Inspection Program (OSSPIP). The OSSPIP surveys every off-site sign in the City of Los Angeles. Currently, each sign is surveyed once every three years.

The City Attorney has prepared a draft ordinance to reduce the time cycle of the OSSPIP from a three-year cycle to a two-year cycle beginning February 1, 2015; however, the council file associated with this report has expired per Council policy.

I THEREFORE MOVE that, matter of the City Attorney Report, dated August 13, 2012, relative to a draft ordinance amending Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 91.6205.18 to reduce the time cycle of the OSSPIP, including various departmental reports thereon, as recorded under Council File No. 11-1122, be reactivated and that the matter be restored to its most recent legislative status as of the date of the File's expiration, including referral to the Planning and Land Use Management Committee.
