

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2015-2016 Operation ABC grant award in the amount of \$100,000 from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to investigate ABC and other code violations during the period July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAPD, or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the 2015-16 Operation ABC Grant in the amount of \$100,000 from the ABC for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
 - b. Execute the 2015-16 ABC Grant Agreement on behalf of the City and submit all necessary documents relative to the grant award and to negotiate, execute and submit any other necessary agreements and documents relative to the grant, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and legality.

2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:
 - a. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in the LAPD Grant Trust Fund No. 339/70.
 - b. Spend up to the grant amount of \$100,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$100,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund 339/70 for the receipt and disbursement of grant funds.
 - b. Increase appropriations on an as-needed basis as follows:

4. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations within this report will allow for the expenditure of the 2015-16 Operation ABC Grant award totaling \$100,000. The grant will provide partial funding for sworn salaries, overtime funding for sworn personnel, and expenses for training, travel, and equipment. No matching funds are required for this grant. The additional sworn salary and all fringe benefits costs are already included in the 2015-16 Adopted Budget and do not represent any additional General Fund impact.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on August 4, 2015, your Public Safety Committee considered Board of Police Commissioners and CAO reports relative to the 2015-2016 Operation ABC grant award in the amount of \$100,000 from the ABC for use by LAPD to investigate ABC and other code violations during the period July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016. The CAO reports that the major objective of Operation ABC is to enforce alcohol laws and to prevent and/or discourage illegal drugs in ABC licensed businesses, sales of alcoholic beverages to minors, intoxicated patrons, illegal solicitation of alcohol, and other related criminal activities. Operation ABC also provides training for alcohol retailers to educate licensees and their employees in promoting the responsible sale, service, and distribution of alcoholic beverages. After an opportunity for public comment was held, your Committee moved to approve the recommendations presented in the CAO transmittal, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for consideration.
