

Your **TRANSPORTATION** Committee

reports as follows:

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to transferring funds to complete the traffic calming measures associated with the Westside Media Center development.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Rosendahl - Koretz), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

AUTHORIZE the Controller to reappropriate \$17,778 from the Neighborhood Traffic Management Fund No. 47H, Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) Account No. 94H194 to LADOT Fund 100/94, Salaries-Overtime Account No. 001090 to complete the traffic calming measures associated with the Westside Media Center development.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

#### SUMMARY

At its meeting held November 23, 2011, Council considered Motion (Rosendahl – Koretz) relative to transferring funds to complete the traffic calming measures associated with the Westside Media Center development. Motion states that Council, in 2011, approved the development of a Neighborhood Traffic Protection Plan to address traffic impacts associated with the Kilroy Realty Corporation's development of the Westside Media Center. The Council action authorized the transfer and appropriation to Fund 100 of \$49,846 for LADOT to implement various traffic calming measures. Expenditures totaling \$32,068 were made in Fiscal Year 2012 and the remaining unexpended amount, \$17,778 reverted back to the Neighborhood Traffic Management Fund No. 47H. LADOT now requests that the reversion amount of \$17,778 be reappropriated to Fund 100 in order to complete the project. Council referred Motion to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held May 22, 2013, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the accompanying Motion.

# TRANSPORTATION

## MOTION

On September 30, 2011, Council approved the development of a Neighborhood Traffic Protection Plan to address traffic impacts associated with the Kilroy Realty Corporation's development of the Westside Media Center (CF 11-1431). The Council action authorized the transfer and appropriation to Fund 100 of \$49,846 for the Department of Transportation to implement various traffic calming measures. Expenditures totaling \$32,068 were made in FY 2012 and the remaining unexpended amount, \$17,778 reverted back to the Neighborhood Traffic Management Fund No. 47H. The Department of Transportation requests that the reversion amount of \$17,778 be reappropriated to Fund 100 in order to complete the project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, AUTHORIZE the Controller to reappropriate \$17,778 from the Neighborhood Traffic Management Fund No. 47H, Department of Transportation Account No. 94H194 to the Department of Transportation Fund 100/94, Salaries-Overtime Account No. 001090 to complete the traffic calming measures associated with the Westside Media Center development.
