COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program from the Office on Violence Against Women, United States Department of Justice (DOJ), and related contract authorities.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the Mayor, or designee, to:
  - a. Accept on behalf of the City, the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program in the amount of \$900,000 for the period October 1, 2012, to September 30, 2014.
  - b. Execute the Grant Award agreement, and AUTHORIZE the Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Public Safety to submit any other necessary agreements and documents relative to the grant award, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
  - c. Execute seven Professional Services Agreements between the City of Los Angeles and seven community-based organizations for the programs listed below for a term of up to 24 months within the applicable grant performance period, not to exceed a cumulative total of \$824,570, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, as follows:

- 2. APPROVE the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program budget, subject to grantor approval, and AUTHORIZE the Mayor's Office of

Homeland Security and Public Safety to expend the grant in accordance with the grantor approved budget.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

- a. Establish a receivable in Fund 52E in the amount of \$900,000, and create new appropriation accounts within Fund 52E, Department 46, as follows:

- b. Expend funds upon presentation of proper demands from the Office of the Mayor.
4. TRANSFER up to \$13,855 from Fund 52E, Account 46J146 to Fund 100, Department 46, Account 001020, for reimbursement of grant-funded personnel salaries in the Mayor's Office.
5. TRANSFER up to \$4,895 from Fund 52E, Account 46J299 to Fund 100, Department 46, Revenue Source 5346 for reimbursement of fringe benefits of grant-funded personnel in the Mayor's Office.
6. AUTHORIZE the Mayor, or designee, to prepare Controller's instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, REQUEST that the Controller implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. Acceptance of the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program award in the amount of \$900,000 will provide funding for the Domestic Abuse Response Team Expansion and Enhancement Program. Acceptance of the grant and the approval of the above recommendations are in compliance with City financial policies in that one-time grant funds will be used for one-time expenditures

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated December 11, 2012 (attached to the Council file), the CAO states that the Mayor requests authority to accept a grant award totaling \$900,000 from the DOJ, Office on Violence Against Women under the FY 2012 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program. Grant funds grant will be used to fund the Domestic Abuse Response Team Expansion and Enhancement program to increase services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault. The CAO recommends approval of the Mayor's request. At the Public Safety Committee meeting held December 14, 2012, the Committee Chair

and Member recommended that Council approve the CAO's recommendations relative to this matter.
