## Council Action

The City Council ADOPTED the following recommendation(s), contained in a COMMUNICATION FROM THE LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (LADOT) which was WAIVED, pursuant to Council Rule 17, by the Chair of the Transportation Committee, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, LADOT, to submit the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER IV) grant application for funding in the amount of \$13 million for the Los Angeles River Bikeway Network; and, if the granted is awarded to the City of Los Angeles, to negotiate and execute an agreement with the United States Department of Transportation on behalf of the City, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
