

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the staffing plan for the Sixth Street Viaduct Replacement Project.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to authorize the employment of the following positions from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, subject to allocation by the Personnel Department and paygrade determination by the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to support the Sixth Street Viaduct Replacement Project:
