ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Section 4.242.9 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code regarding required approval for travel on City business to Sacramento or to Washington, D.C.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Division 4, Chapter 5, Article 4, Subsection (b) of Section 4.242.9 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended by adding the phrase "With the exception of employees of the City Council or office of the Mayor" immediately preceding the phrase "all non-elected City officials and all other City employees...." so that the full text of Subsection (b) shall then read as follows:

(b) *With the exception of employees of the City Council or office of the Mayor*, all non-elected City officials and all other City employees shall notify the Mayor, the Chair of the Intergovernmental Relations Committee and the Chief Legislative Analyst prior to any travel on City business to Sacramento or to Washington D.C.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located in the Main Street lobby to the City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records
