PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the activities and status of the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Supplemental Police Account.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE Board of Police Commissioners report to Council dated March 19, 2013 (attached to the Council file), relative to the status and activities of the Supplemental Police Account for the period October through December, 2012.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated March 15, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD summarizes Supplemental Police Account activity for the period October through December, 2012. During this reporting period, there were 10 Account expenditures in which drugs or assets were seized. These expenditures resulted in 29 arrests and the seizure of \$69,390.00 in United States currency. Also seized were 36,253.44 grams of narcotics with a street value of \$1,642,537.92. On March 19, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's report.

At its meeting held April 12, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council note and file LAPD's report.
