Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the City Engineer to:

- a. Report with recommendations on extending the temporary closure of the three walkways northeasterly of Sharp Avenue between San Fernando Mission Boulevard and MacNeil Street in Mission Hills for an additional eighteen months for public safety reasons
- b. Modify the condition requiring the physical closure of the three walkways by removing the six-month time requirement.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 6, 2018, your Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield) relative to extending the temporary closure of the three walkways northeasterly of Sharp Avenue between San Fernando Mission Boulevard and MacNeil Street in Mission Hills for an additional eighteen months for public safety reasons.
