

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT and COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE relative to amending Council file No. 12-0444, to allow for changes to the public right-of-way in the surrounding area of Grand Avenue and 8th Street.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Huizar - Buscaino):

1. AMEND Council file No. 12-0444 to allow for a 28-foot half roadway, 17-foot sidewalk, and a 7-foot variable width sidewalk easement limited in height to 15-feet above and 6-inches below the finished sidewalk along the east side of Grand Avenue, including the 15-foot x 15-foot corner cut at the intersection of Grand Avenue and 8th Street.
2. DIRECT the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) to issue a Revocable Permit, subject to the applicant satisfying the conditions for issuing such permit prior to the Council's adoption of BOE's report for the 5-foot vacation along Grand Avenue under Street Vacation (E1401198).
3. DIRECT the Department of Planning and the Department of Transportation to allow for a 28-foot half roadway, 17-foot sidewalk, and a 7-foot variable width sidewalk easement limited in height to 15-feet above and 6-inches below the finished sidewalk along the east side of Grand Avenue, including the 15-foot x 15-foot corner cut at the intersection of Grand Avenue and 8th Street.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on June 12, 2013, the Public Works Committee considered a Motion (Huizar - Buscaino) relative to amending Council file No. 12-0444, to allow for changes to the public right-of-way in the surrounding area of Grand Avenue and 8th Street. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Public Works Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion as detailed above.

Subsequently, on August 28, 2013 the Transportation Committee also considered this matter and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Chair and member of the Transportation Committee concurred with the Public Works Committee.

This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
