Subject: RESOLUTION NO. 24-10325: FOURTH AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 899 WITH PACIFIC BATTLESHIP CENTER

Pursuant to Section 606 of the City Charter, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 24-10325 for the proposed Fourth Amendment to Permit No. 899 (P899) with Pacific Battleship Center (Pacific Battleship), a museum and educational facility commonly referred to as the USS Iowa (Iowa). If approved, the proposed Amendment will extend the expiration date of P899 by 30 years from May 24, 2027, currently to May 24, 2057, as proposed. Based upon an effective date of May 25, 2012, approval of the proposed Amendment would result in an aggregate term of forty-five (45) years under P899. Extension options would no longer be included as part of the proposed Amendment, and all other material terms of P899 would remain unchanged. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article III Class 1(14) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines and;
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 24-10325 for the proposed Fourth Amendment to Permit No. 899 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Pacific Battleship Center.
