

PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the exemption of one Project Coordinator position for the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Project Coordinator position for the LADOT from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter, pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Summary:

On April 8, 2014, your Committee considered a March 28, 2014 communication from the Mayor relative to the LADOT's request for Civil Service exemption of one position of Project Coordinator. According to the Mayor, the Project Coordinator position is assigned to LADOT's Bicycle Program. The position reports directly to the Senior Project Coordinator, who manages the Bicycle Program. The Project Coordinator position is responsible for serving as the LADOT's representative at public and interagency meetings; implementing bicycle parking projects and other related projects; assisting in the development and implementation of programs to increase bicycle awareness and use; and conducting studies and maintaining databases to track the use of bicycles, bicycle facilities, and public participation in bicycle-related incentives and programs.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
