COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to amending the Board of Public Works contract with Turner/Jenkins, Martinez, Gales.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the President or two members of the Board of Public Works, to execute Amendment No. 1 to Contract No. C-104390 between the City and Turner/Jenkins, Martinez, Gales, a Joint Venture, to extend the contract term for five years through February 18, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$18 million for continued program management/construction management services for the Proposition Q Citywide Public Safety Bond Program, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. The proposed amendment extends the term of the program management/construction management contract between the City and the above-referenced consulting firm. The maximum compensation of \$18 million for these services are paid by the Proposition Q General Obligation Bond.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor dated July 2, 2012 (attached to the Council file), the CAO states the Bureau of Engineering requests authority to amend the contract with Turner/Jenkins, Martinez, Gales as stated above. Although all original Proposition Q Program projects have been completed, new Phase II projects have been authorized by the Mayor and Council funded by program savings and interest accruals. Turner/Jenkins, Martinez, Gales will continue to assist the City through the life of the Proposition Q Phase II Program and through the closeout of the bond on an as-needed basis. The CAO recommends approval of the Bureau's request. At the Public Safety Committee meeting held July 27, 2012, the Committee Chair and member recommended that Council approve the contract amendment, as recommended by the CAO
