16 COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE relative to the civil service exemption for one Senior Project Coordinator and one Management Analyst II grant-funded positions in the Community Development Department (CDD).

Recommendation for Council action:

RESOLVE that one Senior Project Coordinator and one Management Analyst II grant-funded positions in the CDD, Youth Workforce Division, be EXEMPTED from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter, pursuant to Charter Section 1001(d)(4). The Board of Civil Service Commissioners approved the exemption request from the CDD on October 25, 2012.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CDD reports that there is no impact to the General fund as these positions are grant-funded through the Workforce Investment Act, Workforce Innovation Fund Grant.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 11, 2012, your Committee Chair considered a revised report from the CDD dated December 11, 2012 relative to the civil service exemption for one Senior Project Coordinator and one Management Analyst II grant-funded positions in the CDD. The report, attached to the Council file, provides details on said issue. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair recommended that Council approve the exemption request, as reflected above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
