

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the First Amended and Restated Agreement with Clean Harbors Environmental Services Inc. to provide pick-up and disposal of hazardous waste.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), or designee, to execute the First Amended and Restated Agreement for Contract No. C-125748 on behalf of the City with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. to provide routine pick-up and disposal of hazardous waste at all Fire Department stations and facilities for an amount not to exceed \$650,000, subject to approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the above recommendation will authorize the LAFD to increase the contract limit for hazardous waste pick-up and disposal under Agreement No. C-125748 with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. to \$650,000 over a contract term ending November 1, 2017. The estimated General Fund impact may be up to \$240,000 in 2016-17, which the LAFD intends to fund through identified savings within its current year budget. Funding availability subsequent to 2016-17 will be subject to the appropriation of funds in the annual budget process. The recommendations in this report comply with the City's Financial Policies in that operational costs are supported by budgeted funds.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on February 7, 2017, your Public Safety Committee considered Board of Fire Commissioners and City Administrative Officer reports relative to the First Amended and Restated Agreement with Clean Harbors Environmental Services Inc. to provide pick-up and disposal of hazardous waste. The CAO reports that the proposed first amendment increases the contract limit from \$250,000 to \$650,000 over the life of the contract to accommodate the increased number of pick-up locations; identifies authorized representatives; and updates language to match current City Standard Provisions. The contract term dates will remain the same, from November 2, 2012 through November 1, 2017. The current Contract C-125748, approved by Council on January 19, 2016 (Council file No. 12-1367-S3), utilizes an existing contract (C-121334) between Clean Harbors and the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) with the same term dates of November 2, 2012 through November 1, 2017. The BOS contract with Clean Harbors was executed after Clean Harbors was selected through a competitive Request for Proposals process. An opportunity for public comment was held. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation presented by the Board of Fire Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
