TRANSPORTATION

MOTION

Since 2010 after a very successful inaugural launch of its first event, CicLAvia has become a signature event for the City of Los Angeles. With over 100,000 in attendance at each event, CicLAvia continues to bring together Angelenos of all ages to the streets of Los Angeles. The goals of the event are to promote open space, public transportation, public health and community and economic development.


A majority of the participants at CicLAvia are on bicycles. The City desires to promote the safe and effective use of bicycles and pedestrian awareness. The City receives annually funding from the Transportation Development Act Article 3 Funds from the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority and desires to allocate up to \$950,000 of these funds to support CicLAvia.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

1. INSTRUCT the General Manager of the Department of Transportation (LADOT), to submit the necessary Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Local Claim Forms to the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) to claim TDA Article 3 bicycle apportionment of \$950,000 for CicLAvia of the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 TDA Article 3 Allocation.
2. AUTHORIZE LADOT to receive \$950,000 of TDA Article 3 funds for FY 2012-2013 from MTA, deposit \$950,000 into the Local Transportation Fund No. 207, and appropriate \$950,000 to the CicLAvia Appropriation Unit No. to be assigned.
3. AUTHORIZE the Mayor, with the assistance of DOT, to negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and CicLAvia relative to acceptance of TDA Article 3 funds for CicLAvia as approved by MTA subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality; and authorize the Mayor to execute the MOU on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE to AUTHORIZE the General Manager, DOT, or designee, to make any technical correction or clarification to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this motion, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
