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PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to applying for and accepting a \$630,777 grant award for the 2015 Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (DOJ).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the 2015 ICAC Task Force grant in the amount of \$630,777 from the DOJ for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
 - b. Negotiate and execute the 2015 ICAC Task Force grant Cooperative Agreement on behalf of the city and submit all necessary documents relative to the grant award, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
 - c. Negotiate and execute new or amended agreements with affiliated ICAC Task Force agencies, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:
 - a. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in the LAPD Grants Trust Fund No. 339/70.
 - b. Spend up to the grant amount of \$630,777 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
 - c. Appropriate \$630,777 to appropriation account number to be determined within Fund No. 339/70, for disbursement of the 2015 ICAC Task Force Program.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to increase appropriations for 2015 ICAC Task Force Program as needed from appropriation account number to be determined in Fund No. 339/70, to Fund No. 100/70 account number and amount as follows:

4. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations above report will have no additional impact on the General Fund. Acceptance of the grant is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time revenue is used for one-time expenses.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on January 19, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered Board of Police Commissioners and CAO reports relative to seeking retroactive approval to apply for and accept a \$630,777 grant award for the 2015 ICAC Program from the DOJ, for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. The CAO states that the primary purpose of the DOJ ICAC Program is to ensure law enforcement agencies are equipped to quickly respond to, investigate and prosecute incidents involving the exploitation of children and juveniles through the use of the Internet. The ICAC Program funds can be used to allow the LAPD to enhance investigation of offenders; deliver educational outreach programs; prosecute offenders in federal, state or local courts; serve as a forensic resource to law enforcement agencies within the service area; and participate in nationally coordinated investigations. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations presented in the CAO transmittal, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
