DISCUSSION

The donation will provide for the purchase of six Pro Tech Ballistic Intruder Shields and 18 Point Blank Ballistic Blankets for Metropolitan Division's K9 Platoon. Canine teams are often first responders or the first tactical resource deployed during critical incidents, such as bomb threats, riots or armed suspect searches. By virtue of their specialized training, K9 teams are called to perform dangerous tactical missions, while upholding officer, animal, and public safety. These shields will provide an additional layer of protection for K9 teams.

The Intruder Shields will be provided to supervisors in the K9 Unit, comprised of five sergeants and one lieutenant, to ensure the availability of a shield during any K9 deployment. This shield provides Level IIIA protection and 20"x34" coverage. The Ballistic Blankets are used as an offensive tool, enabling the user to receive multiple projectile impacts while quickly moving forward. The 18 Point Blank Ballistic Shield Blankets will be provided to each K9 officer, to be used during deployments.

No expressed or implied commitment or promises were made to the donor or representative of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendations; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.
