

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to extending the expiration date applicable to the Southern California Gas Company Franchise.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE extending to March 31, 2015, the expiration date applicable to the Southern California Gas Company Franchise Ordinance No. 168164.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

Accompanying a report to Council dated November 5, 2014, the City Attorney presents Ordinance extending the expiration date applicable to the Southern California Gas Company Franchise. In 1992, the City granted for a term of 20 years a franchise authority to the Southern California Gas Company to install, construct, replace, reconstruct, repair, and retain its gas system in streets located in the City of Los Angeles; maintain and operate said gas system; and, engage in the business of the transmission and distribution of gas to customers within the City of Los Angeles. The franchise term has been extended a number of times, the current extension expires December 31, 2014.

At its special meeting held November 12, 2104, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the accompanying Ordinance.
