RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the City’s position to support Senator Boxer’s LINE Act which would set minimum standards at polling places.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz – Rosendahl), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City’s 2013-14 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT of S.58, Senator Boxer’s LINE Act, which would set minimum standards at polling places and ensure that nobody has to wait in line over an hour to cast a vote.
