WHEREAS, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state or federal governmental body or agency must have first been adopted in the form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, AIDS/LifeCycle is a seven-day bicycle ride from San Francisco to Los Angeles to raise money and awareness in the fight against HIV/AIDS and benefits the San Francisco AIDS Foundation and the LA Gay & Lesbian Center; and

WHEREAS, the ride will take place from June 2, 2013 through June 8, 2013 with an expected 2,200 riders and 550 volunteers participating in the event; and

WHEREAS, the event will temporarily impede and restrict the passage of traffic over State Highway Route 1 on June 8, 2013 in the City of Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, AIDS/LifeCycle has applied to the State of California to conduct this bike ride on State property and a support resolution from the City of Los Angeles is necessary to satisfy the requirements for the Caltrans District 7 permit; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Department of Transportation has reviewed the event route and will work with the event sponsor to ensure safe travel for the cyclists and the general public, however, per Department regulations, no spray chalk will be allowed to mark the event route;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that by adoption of this Resolution, the City of Los Angeles hereby SUPPORTS the AIDS/LifeCycle seven-day bicycle ride from San Francisco to Los Angeles, which will pass over State Highway Route 1 on June 8, 2013 in the City of Los Angeles.
