

## Council Action

The City Council ADOPTED the following recommendation(s), contained in a COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHIEF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST which was WAIVED, pursuant to Council Rule 17, by the Chair of the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2013-14 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for SB 53 (De Leon) which would make it a requirement for ammunition purchasers to have a permit to purchase ammunition, and require ammunition vendors to be licensed through the California Department of Justice.

RESOLUTION RULES, ELECTIONS & INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS

WHEREAS, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state or federal governmental body or agency must have first been adopted in the form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, California is a leader in gun control, but imposes very few restrictions on the sale of ammunition; and

WHEREAS, a background check is required for the purchase of a firearm in California, but no such requirement is currently enforced for ammunition purchases; and

WHEREAS, without effective control of ammunition sales, no gun control regime can be truly effective; and

WHEREAS, SB 53 (De León) would initiate controls on the sale of ammunition in California, by requiring purchasers of ammunition to have a permit issued by the state, renewable every five years; and

WHEREAS, ammunition permits created under SB 53 would only be issued to people authorized to own a firearm and purchase ammunition; and

WHEREAS, SB 53 would also require ammunition vendors to be licensed with the California Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the City of Los Angeles has supported ammunition regulation in the past, including permitting ammunition vendors and background checks on ammunition purchasers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that by the adoption of this Resolution, the City of Los Angeles hereby includes in its 2013 - 2014 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 53, which would make it a requirement for ammunition purchasers to have a license to purchase ammunition, and require ammunition vendors to be licensed through the California Department of Justice.
