

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of labor and materials to be used for the refurbishment of a court room for the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) West Los Angeles Youth Programs.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept a donation of labor and materials valued at \$33,875 from the Police and Community Together c/o West Los Angeles Community Police Station for the refurbishment of a court room for the LAPD's West Los Angeles Youth Programs, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated September 13, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of labor and materials to be used for the refurbishment of a court room for the Department's West Los Angeles Youth Programs. The donation consists of demolition labor, electrical work, drywall, paint, ceiling panels, and flooring. The court room will serve as a learning center for use by LAPD's cadets, junior cadets, and Police Activity League. On September 24, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held November 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation and thank the donor for this generous gift.
